



El Mirador Tower – Summer Resident Reminders 2011



Bare feet and beach/pool attire are not permitted in the lobby. Please remove sand from your body and beach equipment before entering the building.

When walking dogs, please enter and exit the building from the garage. Dogs must be leashed at all times. Pet waste bags are provided at several complex locations.

Please do not drape anything over balcony railings (e.g. towels, bathing suits). Balconies may not be used for storage (e.g. bicycles, boogie boards, or surfboards). For information or help with storing these items, please contact the doorman.

Fire code does not permit your front door to be propped open. Anything left in the halls will be removed by building staff. Children are not permitted to play in the hallways.

Garage parking spaces may not be used for storage. Anything left in a parking space will be removed by building staff. Vehicles must not extend beyond their spaces.

As a courtesy to your neighbors, please return luggage and grocery carts to the same room from which they were originally borrowed, immediately after use.

The use of rollerblades, roller skates, skateboards, and scooters is not allowed on the Coronado Shores grounds, which includes the building's garages and terrace.

Bicycles must be registered with the doorman. A limited amount of bicycle storage is available. Riding bicycles is not permitted in the garages. **PLEASE DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO RIDE THEIR BIKES IN THE GARAGE OR AROUND THE GARAGE ENTRY AND EXIT RAMPS.**

Children must be supervised by a responsible adult while in the building and may not create unreasonable noise which could disturb other residents.

We encourage the recycling of paper, glass, plastic, and steel. Please leave your clean recyclables in the trash room on your floor.

El Mirador's door staff monitors the lobby and assists with building safety and access to living units. They are not employed to furnish concierge services and cannot assist individual residents with personal matters.

This notice is supplemental to El Mirador's Rules and Regulations and, as provided by the Association Governing Documents, enforceable by way of fines and the loss of amenity privileges (i.e. swimming pools, tennis courts, health spa, etc.).
