

California, we are suffering the effects of the worst drought in five years.

The economic impact continues to take a toll in the form of higher rates even though conservation methods have increased. But what can we do about it? Glad you asked. Each of us can start by checking our homes for possible leaks.

Toilets are often the main source of interior water use accounting for almost 30% consumption. Fixing a leaky toilet can save between 30 - 50 gallons a day. To check for a leaky tank, place a small amount of food coloring in the tank and wait about 30 minutes without flushing. If the water in the bowl becomes colored by the dye, there is a leak. It might require a new flapper or if it's time to replace the toilet, check online at www.watersmartsd.org for rebates and other water saving tips. Rebates up to \$100 are available on high efficiency (using 1.28 gallons or less per flush) toilets that offer equal or superior performance.
